Final Definitions for Perkins V Reporting_Competencies

- Participant: a student who has successfully completed one PCC.
- Concentrator: a student who has successfully completed two PCCs.
- Completer: a student who has completed all state program competencies with a 2.0 or better.


## Final Definitions for Perkins V Reporting-Segments

Participant: a student who has successfully completed 4-7 segments.
Concentrator: a student who has successfully completed 8-11 segments.
Completer: a student who has completed all 12 segments with a 2.0 or better.
