

Dual Enrollment

Dual enrollments are determined by the colleges. Students must complete an application and meet college requirements to be considered. Per the MCL 388.514, a student that does not receive college credit for a course is required to repay the school district any funds that were expended for the course. To the extent possible, individual exceptions may be considered by the home district. This will be explained to parents/legal guardians during mandatory orientation of all dual enrollment classes, prior to students beginning the class. DCTC will verify student academic progress with the home school mid-way through the semester. Students who are in danger of failing will be contacted by the host school to advise the parent/legal guardian of the students' lack of progress and remind them of their responsibilities to reimburse the district. If the student fails to reimburse the district, they may impose sanctions as determined by school policy. A student may take additional dual enrollment courses if the funds are repaid and they still meet all other eligibility requirements.
